LDM VIEW:- LDM Nalanda, Sri A.K.Choudhary had shared the view regarding that Jeevika is doing a great work to improve the rural poverty and in women empowerment. He appreciated the all trained youth and told them should work for social change.



After the sharing the view from LDM-Nalanda, Rural Development Minister(GoB) shared their view:-

According to RD-Minister-Sri Shrawan Kumar- Addressing to the audience he said, SHG is the powerful body. Due to its successfulness now we are going to implement this programme among all the districts of Bihar. By the virtue of which 10 lakh SHG will be formed during upcoming 5 years in which 1 crore & 25 lakh house hold will be folder in Jeevika SHGs &.

He quotes “JEEViKA initiated a silent revolution in Bihar”. Our Rural societies are now changing and Jeevika is playing a vital key role into this.

He said that more than 3 lakh SHGs are formed by jeevika. Jeevika is performing well in the SHG formation and source of livelihoods creation. More than 2.66 Lakh SHG opened their bank account in

different banks. The main stake holders in Banking are Rural Banks. Their presence in remotest villages, where our community members assess banking activities without any hesitation. It is one of the marvelous achievement of Jeevika is that the down to earth rural women assessing the banking activities. More than 52000 SHGs are availing the 2nd credit linkage facilities and started the petty economic generation activities in villages along with agriculture.

He said- only due to the success of this programme, our Government has been providing all the required finance for the smooth functioning of the different activities under the Jeevika and in future also there should not be the fund crisis to this programme.

The holistic development of the rural poor through reducing the unemployment by making the youth employable. The skill development is an important tool to enhancing the skill for earning more money. Jeevika provides the three months training programme in BPO, Data entry operator, Mason (construction), Hospitality etc. He appreciated the Jeevika for their better work in skill development and placement.



He also throws light on the social security programme like HRF, AABY. He also says that SHGs members are taking easily loan at 1% and take the medical facilities. By using the Social security programme, save health as well as wealth. Sanitation is very important to each and every person. Toilet Construction work and awareness campaign are given to Jeevika. I aspect that Jeevika will do excellent in making the villages free from open defecation. The Govt. is providing Rs 12000 for toilet construction in rural area.

He said that 1650000 cycles are distributed among the rural students .Due to huge number of cycles in the villages, there is a demand of demand of cycle mechanic in the villages. Jeevika should also provide training in Cycle repair for rural school drop outs.

CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTION:-He distributed the certificates among the candidates who have completed their three months training from Sri Ram New Horizon in Data entry operator (computer). The 314 certificates are distributed in this programme at DPCU on 16.08.15
